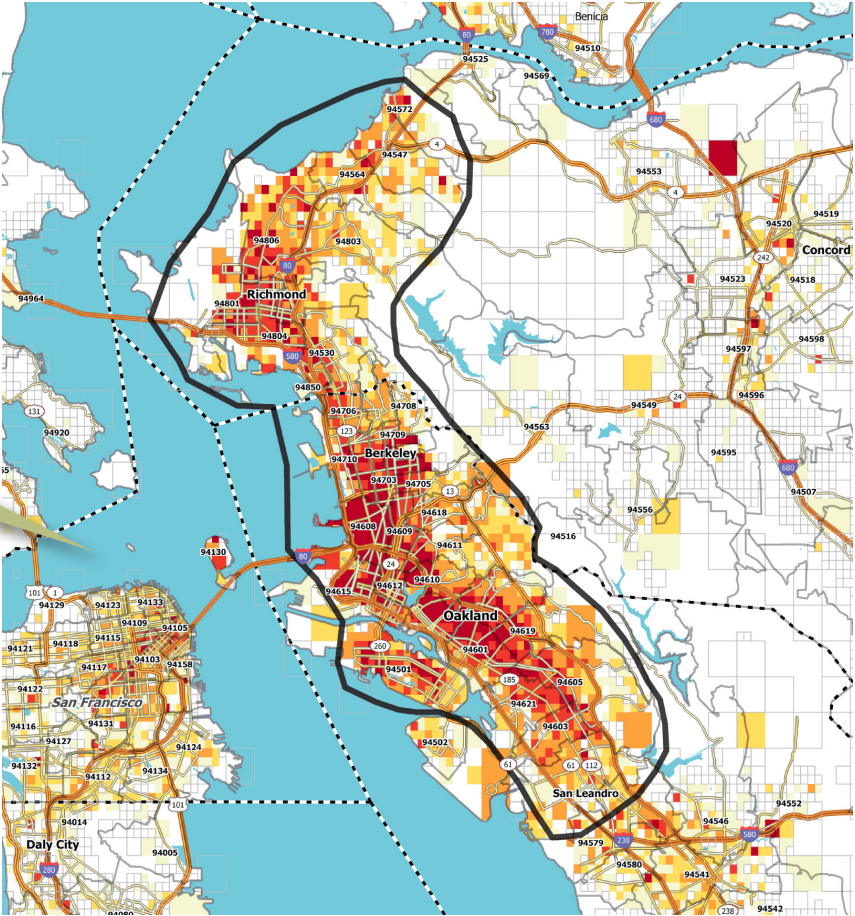
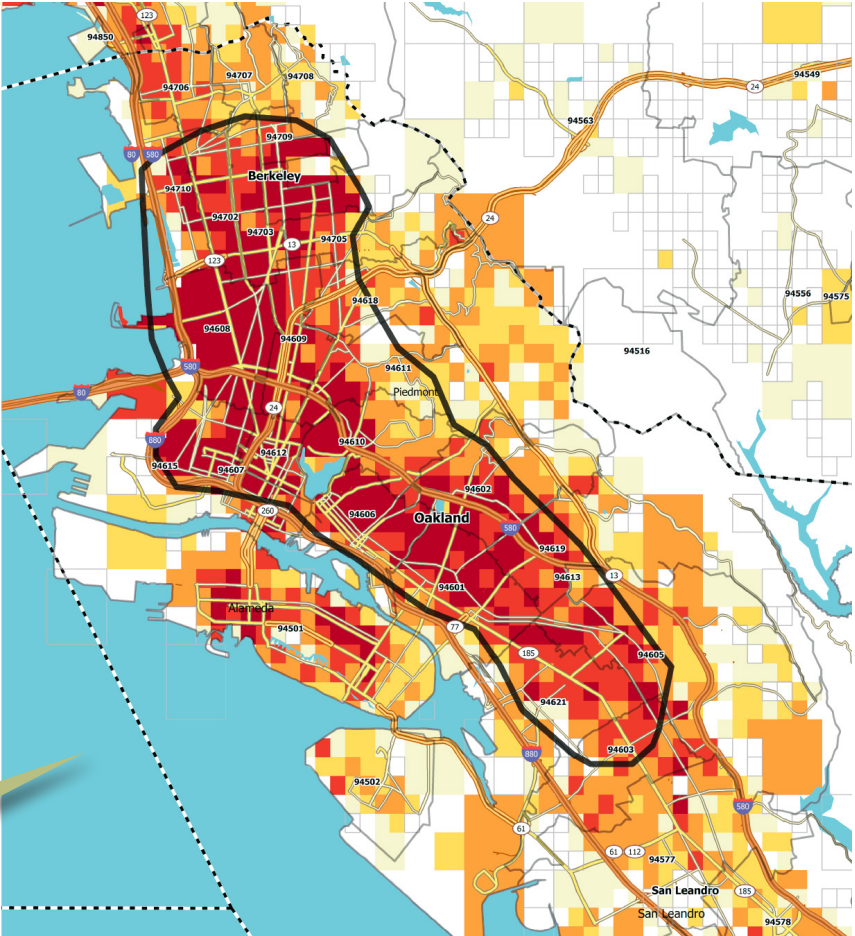


BAY STREET EMERYVILLE HEAT MAPS

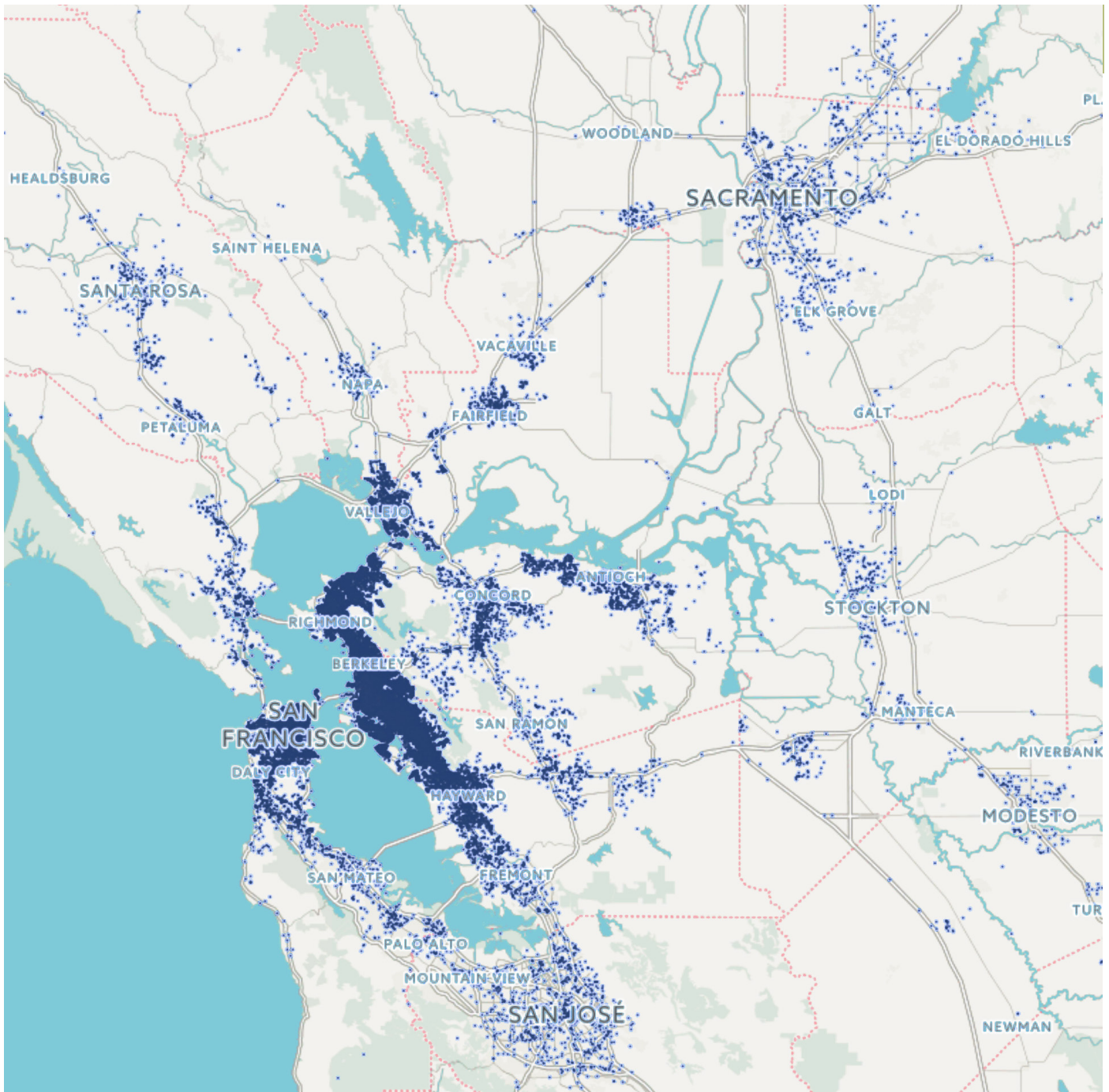

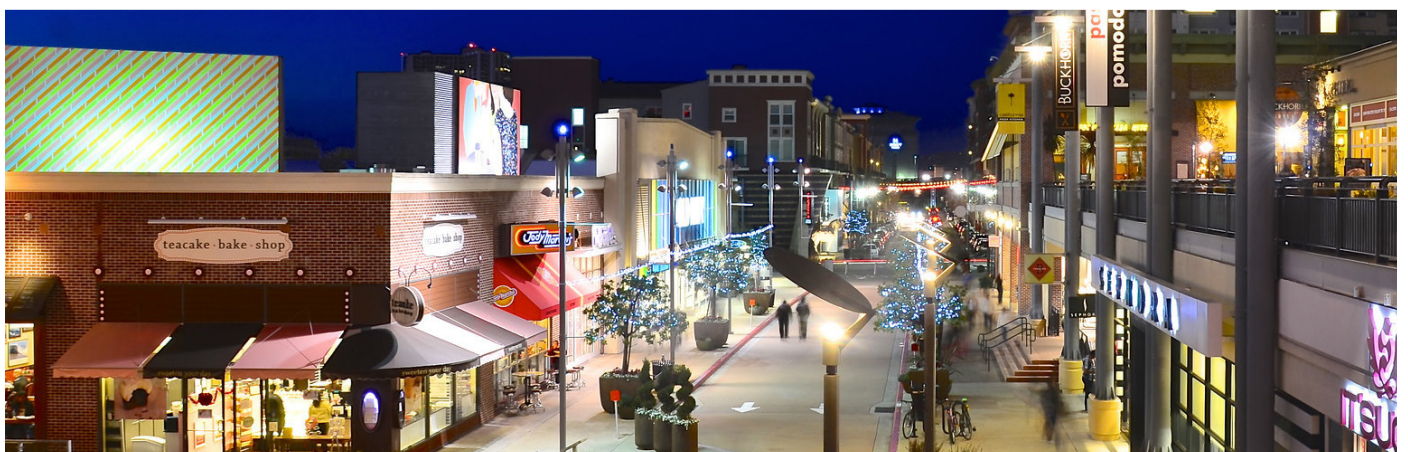
